8:00 PM	Skills Session Critique Sessions – Shannon Allen – How to Contribute Volunteer your work with an open mind – there is a huge range of experience in IFWA IFWA Rules for Submitting: ONE - Writer Put your manuscript in the best possible shape you can make it – have two copies or ready to go at meeting Best format: http://www.shunn.net/format/story.html No more than 5000 words – round it up a bit, ask critters if that is okay, but 5000 words is max State genre when put it up for crit Take notes during crit and ask for clarification TWO - Critiquer First, be open to the work you accept to critique Help improve the work Take to the piece with good intentions – help writer to grow, not tear them apart Try and read the work on authors terms, not yours Be honest, not brutal Be constructive – highlight gems Helpful guided insight – gems and rough spots – have to hear both Comment on the work – I liked or didn't – understanding why did not like it.
