PM	<ul> <li>Editing – Michael Gillett</li> <li>What motivates us to write? Why do we write? To tell stories. At some point, you do it enough, you get better at it.</li> <li>Types of Editing (Freelance)</li> <li>Reader Edits – Higher level edits – most people can give you feedback on higher level</li> <li>Manuscript Critique – Feedback on character development, POV, voice, plot, theme etc. – this is a first edit. \$1500 US for a novel.</li> <li>Editor's Memo – will give examples of inconsistent pacing and how to fix it, overarching themes, narrative voice and what is wrong, reconstructing the plot, missed opportunities for character development, cutting (kill your darlings), repetitive weaknesses, etc.</li> <li>Comprehensive Edit - \$5,000 or more – will be ripped to shreds – tighten dialogue, phrasing, rhythm, line edits</li> </ul>
