She did five minutes of outlining every day and did 4000 or more words a day for many days. She thought she could find more efficiencies. But no idea how she writes. So she made an Excel spreadsheet and in this spreadsheet she takes notes and notices patterns. She did more in afternoon, in a four hour block and not when tired. Other efficiencies - enthusiasm - some days she got 5000 words and others she got 12,000. Difference was whether she was enthused about scene she was writing. Asked "why not just do exciting scenes?" Skip the boring stuff. Knowledge - what will she do Timing - when will she do it? Enthusiasm - does she want to do it? When all three are there, she writes 10K words a day Not everyone gets these spectacular results, but they do get results. Outline a scene and then write it. Outline for five minutes and that is it. Get some metrics to see when you write best. 	Renee Bennett
